The Triangle J Council of Governments has created a Fellowship to provide a graduate student in public administration, city & regional planning, environmental management or a related field an opportunity to contribute to a range of regional development, infrastructure and natural resource planning efforts.

For 2018-19, the fellowship will focus on four activities:

- The Triangle Development & Infrastructure Partnership
- The Research Triangle Economic Development District
- The Clean Water Education Partnership and related water resource planning
- The Center Of the Region Enterprise (CORE), a collaboration of six communities in the heart of the Research Triangle Region

Candidates for the fellowship are expected to demonstrate excellent analytic, writing, research and communication skills.

The Fellowship will involve 20 work hours per week during the Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 semesters. Fellows will be compensated at a rate of \$20 per hour. Opportunities to extend the Fellowship full time during the Summer 2019 and into the 2019-2020 Academic Year will be considered.

The Fellowship will also allow the candidate an opportunity to interact and receive mentorship from local leaders from across the Triangle region.

At the time the Fellowship is awarded, candidates must be enrolled in or accepted into a Graduate Level Course of Study at UNC-Chapel Hill, North Carolina Central University, North Carolina State University or Duke University.

Triangle J Council of Governments is an Equal Opportunity Employer and especially encourages applications from candidates from traditionally under-represented groups.

To apply for the fellowship, all of the following must be provided:

1. A cover letter indicating why the candidate would like to be considered for the fellowship,
2. A resume,
3. A brief writing sample, and
4. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member in the department in which the candidate is enrolled or accepted.
